1. Make sure your file header is present at the top of NB



- 2. Get rid of extra "bling bling" that takes up a lot of space(we're trying to reduce the number of pages printed and save the polar bears, ya know??)
- 3. Edit the Header TO MAKE SURE IT HAS LOOP INVESTMENT HW AND YOUR PERIOD AND SAUCE CODE



4. Choose File Print and then Click on the Page Setup Button
